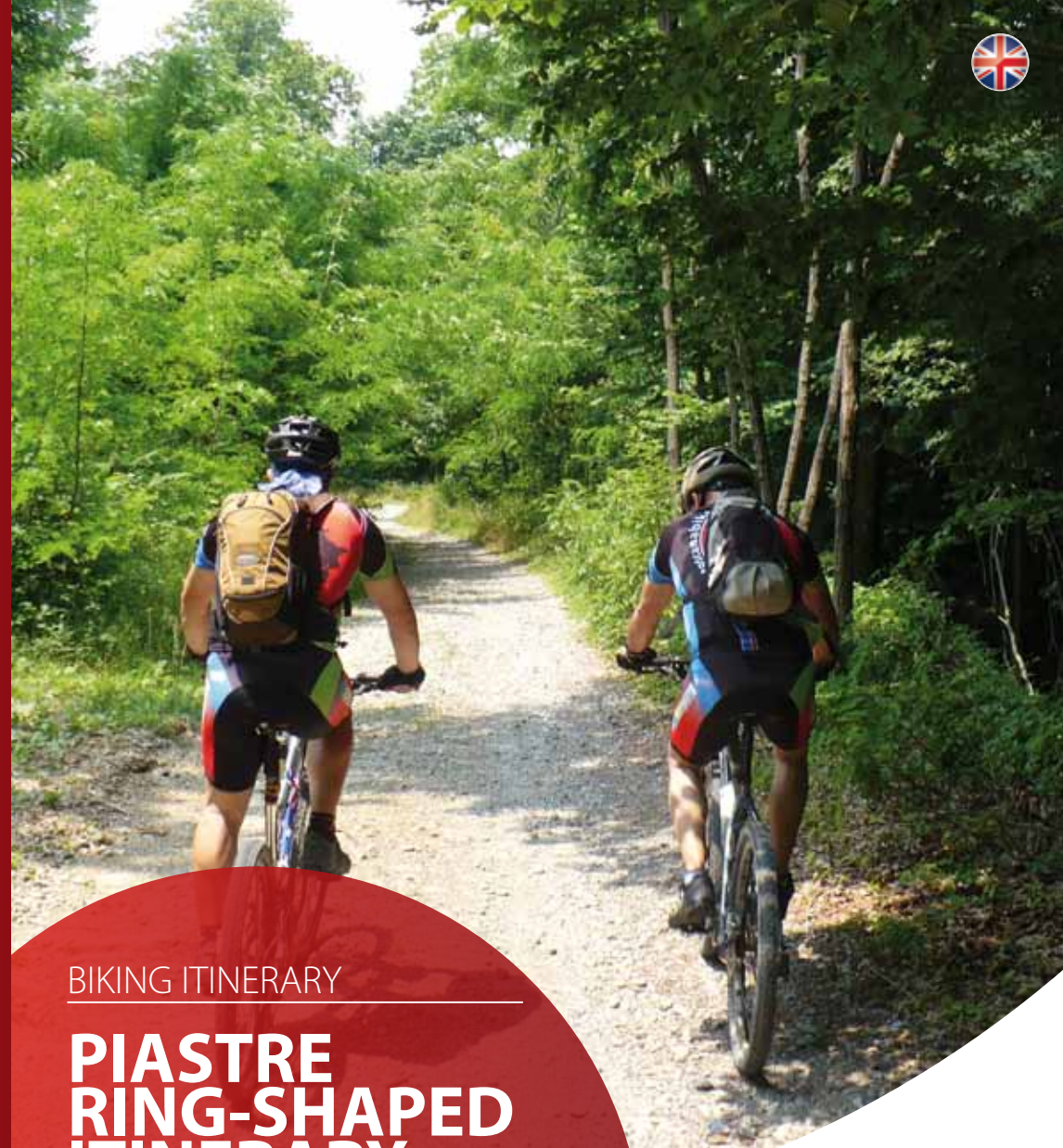




## ROADBOOK

KM	REFERENCE POINT	INSTRUCTIONS
0,000	Campari Fountain	From the parking area behind the fountain, take the SS66 and beside the fountain turn left taking the uphill asphalted road towards INCASSI.
0,150	Crossroad	Keep right.
0,300	Dirt road	Continue along the main slightly uphill dirt road, ignoring all the secondary crossroads.
3,400	Prunetta Crossroad	At the end of the dirt road, turn right at the crossroad, and continue downhill along the SR2.
4,000	Fountain	Pass the hamlet of CASAMARCONI continuing straight ahead downhill.
4,500	Refreshment point	Continue along SR2.
7,400	Crossroad with SS66	Turn right uphill towards PISTOIA.
8,000	Campari Fountain	Arrival.

## PIASTRE RING-SHAPED ITINERARY

Mid-level biking itinerary in the Reno river valley, starting from and returning to Le Piastre. The starting point is reachable from Pistoia both by car (taking the SS66) and by bus, taking Copit's line 54. Well worth a visit in the area are Reno river's old ice houses; buildings where ice used to be produced and stored.

Notes: Pleasantly shady itinerary with good scenic views, particularly along the tarmac stretch going downhill. Unsuitable for riding in winter. Due to the absence of mechanical assistance points, carrying a kit for mending punctures or other mechanical repairs is recommended.

**Main places passed:** Le Piastre and Prunetta

**Points of interest:** mountainous landscape, Ecomuseo della Montagna Pistoiese (Pistoia Mountain Eco-museum)

**Water supply:** easy thanks to the springs along the itinerary

**Mechanical assistance points:** none

**Recommended period:** from April to October

**Type of street surface:** 60% asphalted, 40% dirt road

**Type of bike:** mountain bike

**Level of difficulty:** medium due to the first uphill dirt road section

**Length:** 8 km

**Altitude range:** 186 m.

**Travelling time:** 2 h.
